BEACON OF SAFETY ANNUAL AWARDS CONFERENCE (BOC-AA&C)CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION FOR SCHOOLS

- SCHOOL' ELIGIBILITY: Schools must meet specific criteria, such as DEMONSTRATING BEYOND EXCELLENT STANDARDS of the SSLAG Framework to be eligible for the BOS Awards.
- ELIGIBILITY FOR OTHER STAKEHOLDERS: members of the school community such as: pupils/students, parents, staff, and 3rd parties can be nominated by any stakeholder based on their achievements/ efforts towards creating a safety culture and compliance in schools. on the Safe Schools. (a separate nomination form must be completed for each nominee)
- REGISTRATION: Schools is required to register for the event as soon as they receive the invitation and send in their nomination list latest by the 10th of Sept. 2023.

(All recipient schools will be invited to participate for free based on the condition of participation. See clause 4 below.

- 4. **PARTICIPATION FEE:** There is a participation fee associated with attendance in both the conference and award dinner.
 - a. Recipient schools (BOS):

i)Conference fees: There is Free attendance for 4 staff and 10 students. (for recipient schools wanting to bring more participants, there is an additional fee of N100,000 for a group of 5 adults and 10 students for the conference segment).

ii) Dinner Tickets: Please note that recipient schools are entitled to free dinner tickets for 2 Guests and all the recipient awardees from their schools. Furthermore, Recipient schools are encouraged to invite parents, Board of Directors and well-wishers to attend the award ceremony. There is a fee of N35,000 per head or a table of 10 for N300,000.00.

b. Non-Recipient Schools:

I)Conference fees N25,000 for group of 2 teachers and 5 pupils/students OR N100,000 for an additional 2 teachers and 10 pupils

ii)Dinner Tickets: N55,000 per head or N400,000 for table of 10.

5. **ATTENDANCE**: Schools must satisfy the conditions of participation they opted for or fall under, such as sending exact number of representatives, such as students, teachers, or administrators as communicated in their correspondence. If selected as a finalist or award recipient, attendance at the award dinner is mandatory unless otherwise arranged with the event's organisers.

- 6. DRESS CODE: Conference delegates are expected to be formally dressed in business attire. The Awards Dinner is a Black tie event.
- 7. **Recognition**: Award recipients will be formally recognized during the event and may be required to make a brief acceptance speech during the award dinner.
- 8. **Feedback and Evaluation**: The event organizers may seek feedback from participants to improve future editions of the event.
- 9. **Publicity and Promotion**: By participating, nominees and award recipients grant the event organizers the right to use their names, brand logo and information for promotional purposes as specified in the sponsorship criteria.
